

SYNOPSIS OF KINOO KAHARER THETAR

কিনু কাহারের খেটার

Kinoo Kahar's rag-tag team of performers return from their graves to perform a play about Ghantakarna, the village idiot, who, at his wife's suggestion, becomes a professional confessor. He appears before court and, in exchange for money, confesses to crimes that others have committed. The drama unfolds in *Putna*, a fictitious village in Bengal, being ruled by an incompetent and power-hungry King, his morally-bankrupt Wazir, and a scheming representative of the British East India Company (Laat-Saheb). In a land where greed and power-mongering rules supreme and marriages are built on exploitation, the only person sympathetic to the protagonist is the village notch-girl. As the play progresses it is apparent that Ghantakarna is headed for doom. Would he be made to sacrifice his life to cleanse *Putna* of all wrong-doing? Or, is there hope? More importantly, what does a goat have to do with all this? Come and find out, how it all ends (or not) in Manoj Mitra's pointed trans-period satire, Kinoo Kahar's Theater.

This is not a time that makes it easy for us to keep faith in humanity. With the rise of extremist and isolationist



ideology throughout the globe, it is hard to envision a future, where things are better. Much like the *Raja*, *Ujir*, and *Laat* in this play, everyone seems to be manipulating and exploiting the masses to their benefit

- and the masses seem to fall prey to such manipulations. Maybe what is needed now Is a village idiot, like Ghantakarna, who still believes in his fellow human beings and continues to hope for a better future. Such a person is often ridiculed for being naïve and seldom taken seriously. But, ultimately, it is the idiot who shows that, in the end, WE are our only hope - not any extraneous power, but the human being in ourselves. It is this simple, yet, powerful message that Manoj Mitra delivers in a script that is a treasure chest for an actor. This is the second time I have directed this play in a span of six years. Apart from the central theme of faith amidst this chaotic world, the script is rich in acting potential. The play-in-a-play format allows an actor not only to play the character but also the actor portraying the character. I hope you will enjoy our presentation - Arindam Ghosh
